Company A was organized at Clinton, Iowa, under Capt. C. W. Dunlap, for the 18th Iowa, and was mustered in June 11, 1862. On August 2, 1862, Capt. Dunlap was appointed Major of the 21st Iowa and on the same date Lieut.-Colonel, and his Company was transferred to the same regiment.
